

#### Sanskar Pratishthan



Mental Disability of Children is one of the major social problems amongst the various forms of disability. The children suffering from any disability other than that of mental retardation, can overcome their problems with the help of intellectul strength, but this is not so with mentally retarded children because their IQ is below normal.

Mentally challenged children are considered to be a burden on their own family & also suffer humiliation in the society. They need love, affection and protection, which they hardly get. Parents with a mentally retarded child face number of problems in their day to day life.

We have started a residential school for such differently abled children at Ambadvet, near Pirangut in Pune with a view to find a solution for the problems of these unfortunate children. At this school, our endeavour is to make students self-reliant. Hence, in addition, to routine school education, we teach them various skills. We are constantly making efforts to bring enjoyment and happiness in their lives. Presently nearly 50 students are on our role. They get benefit of free education and residence. We have also thought of a long term plan which would go a long way in helping mentally challenged adults to lead a more comfortable life with the proposed expansion of Agriculture Project on bigger land.



Salient Features of Our School

Education: We have divided children in three groups on the basis of I. Q. The children in each group are imparted routine school education which is commensurate with their intellectual potential. We have a team of trained, experienced and motivated care takers and teachers who have dedicated themselves to the noble cause of educating mentally challenged children. Teachers give individual attention to each child and use variety of teaching aids to fulfill their objective.

Arts: In addition to routine school education, we provide them training in drawing, handicrafts, music and agricultural activities.

**Sports**: The school has its own spacious ground where children enjoy playing outdoor games like cricket. We have fixed swings, jungle-gym and slides on the ground. there are facilities for playing indoor games like carrom. Many prizes have been won by our students in various competitions.

Building and school Environment: The school has its own spacious building and hostel building in the picturesque surrounding of 6 acres of land. The school campus is kept meticulously clean mainly with the help of school children. All the basic amenities are provided to the students. We maintain a small garden and nursery on school campus. Our children actively take interest in gardening activities and they really enjoy it. They look after the seedling and sapling raised in the nursery. We have planted a large number of fruit trees on the School campus.



Fees: No fees is charged to the students who are below 18 years of age. Adult students are charged a nominal fee.

Life-long Scheme: We have made a life-long scheme for the students who are above 18 years of age which takes care of them till the end of their life. The school runs Agro-based activities for these members. The School has 6 acres of fertile land where these members are kept engaged by participating in plantation, watering the plants, cultivation of fruit trees, vermin-culture, up-keepment of cows etc.
